FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS OF DISCIPLINE

The Florida Judicial Qualifications Commission (the "JQC"), served a Notice of

Investigation on Circuit Court Judge Carven D. Angel ("Judge Angel") pursuant to Rule

6(b) of Rules of the JQC based on information received regarding Judge Angel's

conduct during his 2002 re-election campaign. The JQC served and filed a Notice of

Formal Charges on May 23, 2003.

The JQC has now entered into a Stipulation with Judge Angel in which he admits

that during the course of his successful 2002 re-election campaign he (and members of

his immediate family acting on his behalf) attended and spoke at partisan political

gatherings to which his opponent was not invited, attended and campaigned at partisan

political meetings, and publicly represented himself and held himself out as a member

of a political party. This conduct violated Fla. Stat. § 105.071(1) and Canons 7A(1)(d),

7C(3) and 7A(3)(c). The specific charges are set forth in the Stipulation submitted

herewith.

Judge Angel has admitted the foregoing, accepts full responsibility, and

acknowledges that such conduct should not have occurred. It appears that Judge

Angel erroneously but genuinely believed that such campaign conduct was permissible

under controlling federal constitutional law. Judge Angel now recognizes that his understanding was incorrect, but insists he acted honestly and in good faith.

The JQC has concluded that there is nothing in the record which causes it to question Judge Angel's honesty or good faith. Further, there no allegations of improper conduct in office Judge Angel has capably served as a judge in Marion County for 31 years (27 years on the Circuit Court bench and 4 years as a County Court judge). Accordingly, the Commission therefore finds and recommends that the interests of justice, the public welfare and sound judicial administration will be well served by a public reprimand of Judge Angel.
