**PUTATIVE INTERVENOR'S MOTION FOR PERMISSION TO FILE
AMENDED OBJECTION TO DISSOLVING THE STAY**

The Office of Criminal Conflict and Civil Regional Counsel, Third District Court of Appeal Region of Florida ("Regional Counsel" or "RC3"), putative intervenor herein, by and through JOSEPH P. GEORGE, JR., Regional Counsel, hereby seeks permission to file an amended objection to dissolving the stay of the Order Granting In Part And Denying In Part Public Defender's Motion To Appoint Other Counsel In Unappointed Noncapital Felony Cases entered by the Third District Court of Appeal on September 12, 2008, and in support thereof states as

follows.

1. The RC3 has been made aware of one scrivener’s error and further verified a second scrivener’s error believed important enough to warrant amendment of its objection to dissolving the stay, to this court’s attention. The RC3 has been asked to make the State versus County correction by counsel for the Public Defender for the Eleventh Judicial Circuit of Florida (“PD-11”), and has discovered a further error independently. The errors are described below:

- A. The error as to State versus County funding; and
- B. An additional error as to the amount of State funding (\$31.4 Million versus \$26.2 Million).

Wherefore, the RC3 believes the above errors are significant enough to be brought to the attention of the court and requests this court allow amendment as the interests of justice require.
