ORDER OF DISMISSAL WITHOUT PREJUDICE

Plaintiff James C. Bradley, an inmate of the Florida penal system who is proceeding *pro se*, initiated this action by filing a document entitled Statements of Causes for Actions (Complaint) (Doc. 1). The Prison Litigation Reform Act provides:

(g) In no event shall a prisoner bring a civil action or appeal a judgment in a civil action or proceeding under this section if the prisoner has, on 3 or more prior occasions, while incarcerated or detained in any facility, brought an action or appeal in a court of the United States that was dismissed on the grounds that it is frivolous, malicious, or fails to state a claim upon which relief may be granted, unless the prisoner is under imminent danger of serious physical injury.

28 U.S.C. § 1915(g).

This Court takes judicial notice of filings previously brought by Plaintiff Bradley in this Court that were dismissed on the grounds that they were frivolous, malicious, or failed to state a claim upon which relief may be granted: (1) Case No. 3:00-cv-713-J-25B; (2) Case No. 3:00-cv-714-J-25C; and, (3) Case No. 3:00-cv-914-J-21C.¹ The Court also takes judicial notice of some of the cases filed by Plaintiff dismissed based on the three strikes provision: Case Nos. 3:00-cv-1201-J-21A; 3:07-cv-329-J-32TEM; 3:07-cv-341-J-25HTS; 3:07-cv-481-J-20MCR; 3:09-cv-635-J-34MCR; and 3:15-cv-1280-J-32MCR.

Because Bradley has had three or more prior qualifying dismissals and is not under imminent danger of serious physical injury, this action will be dismissed without prejudice.² Bradley may initiate a new civil rights action by filing a new civil rights complaint form and paying \$400.00 (\$350.00 filing fee and \$50.00 administrative fee).

Accordingly, it is now

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED:

1. This case is hereby **DISMISSED** without prejudice.

¹ Plaintiff is no stranger to the federal courts. He has initiated approximately ninety civil rights cases in this Court.

² Plaintiff is apparently seeking the criminal prosecution of a fellow inmate who allegedly masturbated on the wing in the presence of Plaintiff Bradley. Based on the documents attached to the Complaint, Plaintiff's complaint concerning the actions of this inmate has been referred to the Inspector General's Office for an investigation.

2. The **Clerk** shall enter judgment accordingly.

3. The **Clerk** shall close this case.

ORDER OF DISMISSAL WITHOUT PREJUDICE

Plaintiff James C. Bradley, an inmate of the Florida penal system who is proceeding pro se, initiated this action by filing a Civil Rights Complaint Form (Doc. 1) pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983.¹ On April 26, 1996, the President signed into law the Prison Litigation Reform Act (PLRA) which amended 28 U.S.C. § 1915 by adding the following subsection:

(g) In no event shall a prisoner bring a civil action or appeal a judgment in a civil action or proceeding under this section if the prisoner has, on 3 or more prior occasions, while incarcerated or detained in any facility, brought an action or appeal in a court of the United States that was dismissed on the grounds that it is frivolous, malicious, or fails to state a claim

¹ Upon receipt of the Complaint and review of the allegations therein, in an abundance of caution, the Clerk of Court sent a copy of the Complaint and the Standing Order that is entered when an inmate makes a claim of suicidal intent or other imminent physical harm to the Inspector General and to the Warden of Union Correctional Institution, where Plaintiff is currently housed. See Standing Order to Clerk to Notify Inspector General of the Florida Department of Corrections and Warden of Affected Institution Regarding Inmate Claim of Suicidal Intent or Other Imminent Physical Harm (Doc. 3).

upon which relief may be granted, unless the prisoner is under imminent danger of serious physical injury.

28 U.S.C. § 1915(g).

Section 1915(g), commonly referred to as the “three strikes” provision, requires this Court to consider prisoner actions dismissed before, as well as after, the enactment of the PLRA. The Court takes judicial notice of filings previously brought by Plaintiff in a Court of the United States that were dismissed on the grounds that they were frivolous, malicious, or failed to state a claim upon which relief may be granted: (1) 3:00-cv-713-J-25B (dismissed for abuse of the judicial process); (2) 3:00-cv-714-J-25C (dismissed for abuse of the judicial process); and (3) 3:00-cv-914-J-21C (dismissed for abuse of the judicial process).² The Court also takes judicial notice of some of the cases filed by Plaintiff that this Court dismissed based on the three strikes provision: Case Nos. 3:00-cv-1201-J-21A; 3:07-cv-329-J-32TEM; 3:07-cv-341-J-25HTS; 3:07-cv-481-J-20MCR; and 3:09-cv-635-J-34MCR.³

Because Plaintiff has had three or more prior qualifying dismissals and is not under imminent danger of serious physical injury,⁴ this action will be dismissed without prejudice.

² In Rivera, the court found that “dismissal for abuse of the judicial process is precisely the type of strike that Congress envisioned when drafting section 1915(g).” Rivera v. Allin, 144 F.3d 719, 731 (11th Cir. 1998).

³ Plaintiff is no stranger to the federal courts. He has initiated almost ninety (90) civil rights cases in this Court alone.

⁴ Although Plaintiff claims he is in danger, Complaint at 7, none of his allegations support such a finding. Plaintiff’s Complaint is not a model of clarity, but from what the Court can decipher, he contends that an officer who is not named as a defendant in this case wrote a false disciplinary report, and some other officers and mental health staff gave Plaintiff three shots of medication in an attempt to harm him. He also asserts that Defendant Greenfield threatened to forcibly medicate him. The attachments to the Complaint do not appear to


Plaintiff may initiate a new civil rights action by filing a new civil rights complaint form and paying the full \$400.00 filing fee.
