PETITIONER RPPTL SECTION'S SECOND MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

The Real Property, Probate and Trust Law Section of The Florida Bar (hereinafter "Petitioner"), moves for an extension of time and states as follows:

1. Petitioner requests an extension of time of ten (10) days in which to file its Objections and Petitioner's Brief. An extension is required due to drafting and administrative coordination necessary to file materials on behalf of the Petitioner.

2. Pursuant to Rule 10-9 of the Rules Regulating The Florida Bar, Petitioner on or about March 28, 2012, petitioned the Standing Committee on Unlicensed Practice of Law of The Florida Bar (hereinafter "Standing Committee") for an advisory opinion on certain activities of community association managers licensed pursuant to Part VIII of Chapter 468 of the Florida Statutes.


3. On May 15, 2013, after public notice and a hearing, the Standing Committee issued its Proposed Advisory Opinion, FAO#2012-2.

4. Pursuant to Rule 10-9.1(g)(3) of the Rules Regulating The Florida Bar, within 30 days after the filing of the opinion with the Court, Petitioner may file with the Court objections and a brief in support thereof. The current deadline, following Petitioner's first motion for an extension, is July 15, 2013. The Rule also provides that Petitioner may request a reasonable extension of the time periods provided in the Rule.

5. Upon consultation the Standing Committee has no objection to the granting of this Motion.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner hereby requests an extension of time to and including July 25, 2013, in which to file its Objections and Petitioner's Brief.


