Pursuant to Fla. R. App. P. 9.225 petitioner notifies the Court the United States Supreme Court has accepted *certiori* review of cases pertinent to the issue before this Court:

On December 11, 2015, the United States Supreme Court consolidated three cases for review; <u>Birchfield v. North Dakota</u> (14-1468), <u>Bernard v. Minnesota</u> (14-1470), and <u>Beylund v. North Dakota</u> (14-1507). The lead case is <u>Birchfield</u> and a copy of the Court's Order granting <u>certiorari</u> and consolidating for review is attached. This decision is pertinent because the Court will determine the constitutionality of a statute criminalizing the refusal to submit to a breath test which is the issue presented in the instant case. Further, the District Court relied on <u>Birchfield</u> and <u>Bernard</u> in deciding <u>Williams v. State</u>, 167 So. 3d 483 (Fla. Dist. Ct. App. 2015), <u>reh'g denied</u> (July 1, 2015)
