**NOTICE OF SUPPLEMENTAL AUTHORITY- *CERTIORI* BEFORE THE
UNITED STATES SUPREME COURT**

Pursuant to Fla. R. App. P. 9.225 petitioner notifies the Court the United States Supreme Court has accepted *certiori* review of cases pertinent to the issue before this Court:

On December 11, 2015, the United States Supreme Court consolidated three cases for review; *Birchfield v. North Dakota* (14-1468), *Bernard v. Minnesota* (14-1470), and *Beylund v. North Dakota* (14-1507). The lead case is *Birchfield* and a copy of the Court's Order granting *certiorari* and consolidating for review is attached. This decision is pertinent because the Court will determine the constitutionality of a statute criminalizing the refusal to submit to a breath test which is the issue presented in the instant case. Further, the District Court relied on *Birchfield* and *Bernard* in deciding *Williams v. State*, 167 So. 3d 483 (Fla. Dist. Ct. App. 2015), *reh'g denied* (July 1, 2015)
