Florida, No. 14-7505, 2016 WL 112683 (Jan. 12, 2016), to each of Appellant/Petitioner's first-degree murder convictions and sentences of death, including whether Hurst is retroactive, the effect of Hurst given the aggravating factors in Lambrix's case, and whether any error is harmless. 
NO CONTINUANCES WILL BE GRANTED EXCEPT UPON A SHOWING OF EXTREME HARDSHIP.
