NOTICE OF INTENT TO SEEK REVIEW OF REPORT OF REFEREE



1. The Florida Bar requests this Court review the Report of Referee for this disciplinary matter, docketed on May 22, 2018.
2. The Referee found Respondent not guilty of violating R. Regulating Fla. Bar 3-4.3 and 4-8.4(c). The Referee entered a subsequent order directing each party to bear its own taxable costs.
