MOTION TO STAY PROCEEDINGS

The Florida Judicial Qualifications Commission, by and through the undersigned counsel, hereby notifies this Court that the Investigative Panel of the Commission has commenced, pursuant to Art. V, §12 of the Florida Constitution, an inquiry into new matters involving Judge Robinson.

In the present case, the Investigative Panel has determined that probable cause exists to support the charges filed, and it has reached a Stipulation with Judge Robinson in which she admits that her conduct violated the Code of Judicial Conduct. However, since then, additional matters have come to the attention of the Investigative Panel which require further proceedings before that body.


Because these new matters may impact the resolution of this case, and to avoid prejudice to the parties, the Commission respectfully requests that this Court stay the proceedings in the present case until the Investigative Panel has concluded its inquiry into the new matter. The Commission is constrained from providing further information because proceedings before the Investigative Panel are confidential. See Art. V, §12(a)(4).

Once the Investigative Panel has concluded its inquiry, the Commission will notify the Court whether it will maintain the Stipulation and Recommendation entered in this case.


