
NOTICE OF VOLUNTARY DISMISSAL

On December 14, 2017, the Commission filed a motion to stay consideration of the Formal Charges, Stipulation, and Findings of Fact and Recommendation of Discipline that had been filed concurrently on November 30, 2017. The Court granted the Commission's request for a stay by order dated December 21, 2017, which also directed the Commission to notify the Court when the Investigative Panel had completed its inquiry into the new additional matters.

The Investigative Panel has now concluded its inquiry, and hereby gives notice of its voluntary dismissal of the charges in the instant matter involving Judge Claudia Robinson. The Commission invokes Rule 1.420, Florida Rules of Civil Procedures because this notice is given prior to the final hearing before the Hearing Panel. Alternatively, the Commission seeks dismissal under Rule 9.350(b), Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure. The basis for the dismissal is Judge Robinson's resignation from the position of Broward County Judge, effective February 12, 2018.


