**VERIFIED MOTION FOR ADMISSION TO APPEAR
PRO HAC VICE PURSUANT TO
FLORIDA RULE OF JUDICIAL ADMINISTRATION 2.510**

Comes now Roy L. Austin, Jr., Movant herein, and respectfully represents the following:

1. Movant resides in Maryland and Movant is not a resident of the State of Florida.
2. Movant is an attorney and a member of the law firm of Harris, Wiltshire & Grannis LLP, with offices at 1919 M Street, NW, 8th Floor, Washington, D.C. 20036. Tel: (202) 730-1300.
3. Movant has been retained personally or as a member of the above named law firm on March 19, 2017 by Aramis Ayala to provide legal representation in connection with the above-styled matter now pending before the above-named court of the State of Florida.

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4. Movant is an active member in good standing and currently eligible to practice law in the following jurisdictions:

District of Columbia – Bar No. 980360

Illinois – Bar No. 6228785

5. There have been no disciplinary, suspension, disbarment, or contempt proceedings initiated against Movant in the preceding 5 years, except he is currently suspended from the California Bar due to voluntary non-payment of dues and voluntary decision to not maintain California continuing legal education requirements while not a practicing attorney. Reinstatement is pending.

6. Movant, either by resignation, withdrawal, or otherwise, never has terminated or attempted to terminate Movant's office as an attorney in order to avoid administrative, disciplinary, disbarment, or suspension proceedings.

12. On March 27, 2017, Movant filed a motion to appear on behalf of Aramis Ayala as counsel *pro hac vice* in *State of Florida v. Markeith Demangzlo Loyd* (Case No. 48-2016-CF0915738-O-A), in the Florida Ninth Judicial Circuit, but that motion was denied for reasons unrelated to Movant's qualifications. On April 11, 2017, Movant filed a motion to appear on behalf of Aramis Ayala *pro hac vice* in another case pending before this Court styled *Aramis Donell Ayala v. Rick Scott, Governor* (Case No. SC17-653). That motion was granted on April 11, 2017. Also on April 11, 2017, Movant filed a motion to appear on behalf of Aramis Ayala *pro hac vice* in the United States District Court for the Middle District of Florida in the case styled *Aramis Ayala v. Richard L. Scott and Brad King* (Case No. 6:17-cv-00649-CEM-TBS). That motion was denied without prejudice on April 11, 2017, and Movant will re-file that motion. Movant has not filed any other motions to appear as counsel in Florida courts during the past five (5) years.



WHEREFORE, Movant respectfully requests permission to appear in this court for this cause only.




