STATE'S MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE REPLY

Petitioner, STATE OF FLORIDA, by and through the undersigned Assistant Attorney General, hereby moves:

1. The State's Reply brief is due before this Court. Pursuant to the Court's default briefing order, the State was allowed 30 days to file a Reply.
2.
