**CITIZENS' UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR ACCEPTANCE OF
CORRECTED INITIAL BRIEF**

Pursuant to Rule 9.300, Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure, Appellant the Citizens of the State of Florida, by and through the Office of Public Counsel ("OPC"), hereby file this unopposed motion for an order accepting the Corrected Initial Brief from the Citizens. In support of this Motion, OPC states:

1. This case is an appeal by the OPC of Florida Public Service Commission Order No. PSC-2018-0014-FOF-EI. The Notice of Administrative Appeal in this case was filed on February 5, 2018, and pursuant to Rule 9.110(f), as extended for two weeks by Order of the Court, the Appellant's Initial Brief was filed on May 1, 2018.

2. Corrections to Citizens Initial Brief are required to fix a pagination change necessitated by an error by undersigned counsel in preparing the originally

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filed Appendix to Citizens' Initial Brief. Due to the undersigned's failure to follow the numbering convention required by the current Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure, numbering for all substantive documents included in the Appendix are uniformly off (too low) by four pages. That Appendix was rejected by Order of the Court for lack of conformity with the Appellate Rules' formatting and filing protocol. The Corrected Appendix that has now been filed contains pagination that is different throughout by a constant of four pages when compared to the original. The Citizens have corrected each numerical reference to the Appendix in the Corrected Initial Brief so that Initial Brief now corresponds to the Corrected Appendix. The only change made to the Initial Brief that was filed on May 1, 2018 is to add four pages in each of 34 locations containing such instances of a citation reference or group of citation references to the Appendix. There are no substantive changes to the Initial Brief or the Appendix. No words were changed and no information on any page was changed, except for the specific Appendix page citations. The only corrections are the specific edits required to synchronize Corrected Initial Brief references to the Corrected Appendix locations. All of the documents in the Appendix are exhibits admitted in the hearing or are the Order under appeal.

3. The Citizens' Corrected Initial Brief is will be filed contemporaneously with this motion contingent upon the Court's acceptance thereof.

4. OPC certifies that on May 2, 2018, it contacted the attorneys for Appellees Florida Public Service Commission, Florida Power & Light, Duke Energy Florida, Gulf Power Company, Tampa Electric Company, Florida Industrial Power Users Group, PCS d/b/a White Springs Phosphate, and Southern Alliance for Clean Energy, and is authorized to represent that the Appellees either agree to, or do not oppose, or take no position on this Motion.

WHEREFORE, the Citizens of the State of Florida respectfully request the Court to accept for filing OPC's Corrected Initial Brief, as specified in this motion.
