**MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE *AMICUS* BRIEF ON

REVISION COMMISSION**

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On May 22, Certain Commissioners of the 1998 Constitution Revision Commission (“Commissioners”) filed a motion for leave to file a brief as *amici curiae* on behalf of Petitioners (“Motion for Leave”). The Motion for Leave is pending before this Court. On June 4, 2018, Petitioners filed their merits brief. Pursuant to Fla. R. App. P. 9.370(c), the Commissioners’ amicus brief is due today, June 14, 2018.

Accordingly, pursuant to Fla. R. App. P. 9.300(a), the Commissioners hereby request, if the Motion for Leave is granted, an extension of time to file their amicus brief until two days after the Court grants the Motion. The Commissioners correspondingly request, pursuant to Fla. R. App. P. 9.300(d)(13), that the time to file the amicus brief be tolled until the Court has ruled on this motion.

Counsel for the Commissioners has conferred with counsel for Plaintiffs, counsel for Intervenor-Defendants, and counsel for Respondents, who stated that they do not oppose the Commissioners’ request for an extension of time to file.
