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**PETITIONER’S UNOPPOSED MOTION TO
EXTEND PAGE LIMIT FOR REPLY BRIEF**

Pursuant to Fla. R. App. P. 9.210(a)(5)(E), Petitioners respectfully move this Court for leave to file a 25-page reply brief, due on August 13, 2018. In support of this motion, Petitioners state:

1. Respondents were permitted an enlarged Answer Brief and filed a 60-page brief.
2. Intervenors/Respondents filed a 38-page Answer Brief.
3. Five amicus briefs supporting Respondents and Intervenors have been filed, totaling 80 pages.
4. In light of the considerable legal arguments advanced by Respondents,

Intervenors, and the amicus curiae in their support, Petitioners submit there is good cause to extend the 15-page limit set forth in Rule 9.210(a)(5)(B) and request leave to include an additional 10 pages in their Reply Brief.
