APPELLANT'S STATUS REPORT

Appellant, **ERIC KURT PATRICK**, by and through undersigned counsel hereby files the instant status report concerning the above-styled case:

1. This proceeding involves the appeal of the circuit court's December 27, 2018 order denying Mr. Patrick's claim of ineffective assistance of counsel during voir dire.
2. On January 25, 2019, Mr. Patrick filed a Notice of Appeal to this Court Directions to the Clerk and a Designation to the Court Reporter.
3. On January 30, 2019, this Court issued an Acknowledgment of New Case and issued a separate order regarding the preparation of the record on appeal in this case. This Court also directed the court reporters to start immediately transcribing the proceedings and to file them with the trial court clerk within fifty

days from the filing of the Notice of Appeal. The transcripts were due no later than March 16, 2019.

4. The order also directed that the trial court clerk shall have twenty days after the completion of the filing of the transcripts to file the record on appeal with this Court.

5. On March 21, 2019, undersigned counsel contacted the Clerk of Court to inquire of the status of the transcripts and record on appeal. At that time, undersigned counsel was told that one transcript remained outstanding. A copy of the transcript from the evidentiary hearing had been filed prior to the Notice of Appeal and Designation.

6. On that same date, undersigned counsel contacted Boss Certified Real Time Reporting (Boss) to inquire about the status of the transcripts. A representative for Boss indicated that the designation was not received. Undersigned counsel then emailed a copy of the designation and a copy of this Court's January 30, 2019 Order to Boss. Receipt of both was confirmed via email.

7. On March 27, 2019, undersigned counsel again contacted Boss to inquire of the status of the transcripts. Undersigned counsel received the court reporter's acknowledgment (attached hereto) in response indicating the transcripts would be completed and filed on or before April 22, 2019.

8. Undersigned counsel will continue to monitor the completion of the record on appeal.
