
ADVISORY OPINION TO THE
ATTORNEY GENERAL

RE: ALL VOTERS VOTE IN
PRIMARY ELECTIONS FOR
STATE LEGISLATURE,
GOVERNOR, AND CABINET (FIS)

This proceeding, in which the Attorney General seeks direct review by this Court of a financial impact statement corresponding to an initiative petition proposing an amendment to the Florida Constitution, is hereby dismissed for lack of jurisdiction. *See Advisory Op. to the Att’y Gen. re Raising Florida’s Minimum Wage*, Nos. SC19-548 & SC19-736, slip op. at 14 (Fla. Dec. 19, 2019).
