1. The Referee was appointed on April 2, 2019 and the Report of Referee is due no later than September 29, 2019.
2. The final hearing was originally set for September 9-10, 2019.
3. Discovery is ongoing in the instant case.
4. On July 11, 2019, the Second Circuit Grievance Committee 2A found probable cause against the Respondent in Florida Bar File No. 2019-00,088.
5. The Florida Bar will file a formal complaint in the above-referenced matter.


6. Counsel for the parties stipulated to consolidating the cases for the purpose of trial or settlement and will need additional time to prepare the new case.

WHEREFORE, The Florida Bar prays this Honorable Court will issue an order granting the Referee an extension of time until January 27, 2020 to file his report in this matter.


