**MOTION TO PERMIT INITIAL BRIEF OF 26,776 WORDS, ATTACHMENTS A-E, AND
NOTICE OF FILING DISQUALIFICATION OF REFEREE VALIDATING THAT REPORT OF
REFEREE WAS CLEARLY AND CONVINCINGLY WRONG**

COMES NOW Respondent, pursuant to Rule 9.300 (a), hereby submits his request to permit the Initial Brief to be 26,776 words, include the Attachments A-E, and include the Notice of Filing the Disqualification of the Referee from the same set of facts, and by the same extortionate, perjurious, Bar Rule violating scheming attorney, which document the clearly and convincingly wrong Report of Referee, and the Bar Rule violations of the Florida Bar Attorney, the Accounting Rule and Statute violations by the Florida Bar Accountant, and Cannon 3(D) violations by the Referee.

The grounds for this motion are as follows:

(1) There were two distinct bar complaints that entailed two distinct trials and records. This required the substance of two briefs, which would be 26,000 words, and the Initial Brief is 776 words above that amount.

(2) The Initial Brief had to be updated based on receiving transcripts from the Court Reporter.

(3) Attachments A-E, more fully inform the Court of the criminal extortion, perjury, extensive Bar Rule violations by the perpetrator, attorney JB Harris, Bar Rule violations of the Florida Bar attorney, accounting violations by the Florida Bar accountant, and Cannon 3(D) violations by the Referee.

(4) The Notice of Filing the Disqualification of the Referee verifies the substance of the criminal extortion, perjury, extensive Bar Rule violations by the perpetrator, attorney JB Harris, Bar Rule violations of the Florida Bar attorney, accounting violations by the Florida Bar accountant, and Cannon

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3(D) violations by the same Referee that submitted the Report of Referee, which is the basis for this appeal, which violations took place in the Report of Referee and the underlying trial of the matter, and required his disqualification.

(5) If the Court or the Court's Clerk need Respondent to update the record, this motion, or any other matter to ensure compliance with the Florida Rules of Appellate procedure, as he is not a regular appellant practitioner, please inform the Respondent and he will promptly do so.

WHEREFORE RESPONDENT in order to advance the efficient and accurate administration of justice, and to fully inform the Court of the clear and convincingly wrong Report of Referee, and its Bar Rule, Accounting Rule and Statutes, criminal extortion and perjury, and Cannon 3(D) violations by attorney JB Harris, Florida Bar attorney Shanee Hinson, Florida Bar accountant Roy F. Jeter, and Honorable Paul S. Bryan, and to restore the integrity and credibility of the judiciary, this motion is submitted and should be granted.
