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**MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME
TO FILE REPLY/ANSWER BRIEF**

Pursuant to Rule 9.300, Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure, Complainant The Florida Bar (“TFB”) moves the Court for an extension of time in which to file and serve TFB's reply/answer brief in support of its notice of intent to seek review and in response to the brief submitted by Respondent Alan Howard Ramer in support of his cross-notice for review. In support thereof, TFB states as follows:

1. On July 1, 2021, TFB filed a notice of intent to seek review of the May 2021 Report of Referee. Also on July 1, 2021, Mr. Ramer filed a cross-notice of intent to seek review of the Report of Referee.
2. On August 2, 2021, TFB filed its initial brief in support of its notice of intent to seek review.

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3. After a series of extensions, Mr. Ramer's deadline to file his answer brief in response to TFB's initial brief and in support of his own cross-notice for review was extended to December 30, 2021.

4. Pursuant to Rule 3-7.7(c)(3), Rules Regulating the Florida Bar, TFB must file its reply/answer brief by January 19, 2022.

5. Given the undersigned's other briefing deadlines in TFB and other matters, and the withdrawal of one of the attorneys representing TFB in this matter, the undersigned requests this Court extend TFB's deadline to file and serve its reply/answer brief to and including February 8, 2022, which would extend TFB's deadline to file that brief by 20 days.

6. Pursuant to Rule 9.300(a), the undersigned is authorized to represent that Mr. Ramer does not object to the requested extension.
