MOTION OF THE RULES OF JUDICIAL ADMINISTRATION COMMITTEE  
FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE RESPONSE

Michael Korn, Chair of the Rules of Judicial Administration Committee (“RJA Committee”), and Michael Schmid, Chair of the Ad Hoc Joint Rules Subcommittee (“Joint Subcommittee”) on Marsy’s Law, file this motion to extend the current January 25, 2021, deadline for the Committee and Joint Subcommittee to file a response to the comments in this case. Upon receipt of the comments on January 4, 2021, the Joint Subcommittee reviewed the proposed amendments in light of the comments and prepared a written response. That response was presented to the RJA Committee in its January 16 meeting and was conceptually approved. The chairs are now working together to complete the response, however, as this case is traveling in tandem with *In re: Amendments to Florida Rule of Appellate Procedure 9.143*, SC20-1129, and the Appellate Court Rules Committee has asked for an extension until March 1, 2021, the chairs of the RJA Committee and the Joint Ad Hoc Committee also seek an extension until March 1, 2021.

The committees, through the Florida Bar liaison, have reached out to the commenters regarding this request for extension and no objection to this motion was expressed.

WHEREFORE, the RJA Committee and Joint Ad Hoc Rules Subcommittee respectfully request an extension until March 1, 2021, to respond to the comments filed in this case.
