Judgment is entered for The Florida Bar, 651 East Jefferson Street, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-2300, for recovery of costs from Timmy W. Cox, Sr., in the amount of \$1,250.00, for which sum let execution issue.

Not final until time expires to file motion for rehearing, and if filed, determined. <u>The filing of a motion for rehearing shall not alter</u> <u>the effective date of this suspension.</u>
