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**UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR LEAVE TO FILE BRIEF  
OUT OF TIME AND FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE BRIEF**

Respondent, Gregory Saldamando, through his undersigned counsel, respectfully moves this Court for an order authorizing the filing of his brief out of time and for an extension of time within which to file his brief, and in support states:

1. The Complainant, The Florida Bar, filed its initial brief with this Court on August 27, 2021.

2. Pursuant to Rules Regulating The Florida Bar, Rule 3-7.7(c)(3), the brief of the Respondent was due to be filed with this Court within twenty (20) days of service of the initial brief, which was August 27, 2021.

3. Regrettably the Respondent calendared the deadline for his Answer Brief to be thirty (30) days after the filing of the initial brief,

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rather than the appropriate 20-day period, which has rendered the Respondent's brief past due.

4. Counsel for the Respondent has communicated with Mr. Chris Altenbernd, counsel for the Complainant, who has represented that the Complainant has no objection to the Respondent filing his brief out of time, and no objection to an extension of time of twenty-nine (29) days within which to file the brief. This is the same period of time to which Respondent had consented when the Complainant sought a prior extension.

5. Counsel has been diligently involved in several unrelated obligations. Additionally the record in this matter is extensive requiring detailed review. No previous extension has been requested by the Respondent.

WHEREFORE, the Respondent seeks this Court to allow the filing of the answer brief out of time and for an additional twenty-nine (29) days within which to file the answer brief.
