NOTICE OF INTENT TO SEEK REVIEW OF REPORT OF REFEREE

COMES NOW, The Florida Bar, pursuant to rule 3-7.7(c)(1) of the Rules Regulating The Florida Bar and files this Notice of Intent to Seek Review of Report of Referee and says:

1. The bar requests this court review the report of referee docketed on May 7, 2021.
2. The referee recommends a public reprimand and payment of the disciplinary costs.
3. At its meeting that ended May 21, 2021, the Board of Governors of The Florida Bar (the "Board") considered this case, and voted to file a Notice of Intent to Seek Review of Report of Referee. More specifically, the Board voted to seek review of:
