1. In Florida Supreme Court Case No. SC21-1566, by order dated November 12, 2021, respondent was suspended pursuant to Rule 3-7.2(f), effective immediately.

2. Pursuant to the Court's order, respondent was required to submit the affidavit in compliance with Rule 3-5.1(h), Rules Regulating The Florida Bar, to this office within 30 days of the Court's order, to wit: December 13, 2021.
