**PETITION FOR PERMANENT DISCIPLINARY REVOCATION  
WITHOUT LEAVE TO APPLY FOR READMISSION**

COMES NOW Petitioner, Gary W. Kovacs, and submits this Petition for Disciplinary Revocation pursuant to Rule Regulating Fla. Bar 3-7.12 and states:

1. Petitioner knowingly and voluntarily submits this petition with full knowledge of its effect.
2. Petitioner is 57 years old and has been a member of The Florida Bar since April 26, 1993. On February 22, 2018, this Honorable Court accepted petitioner's Petition for Disciplinary Revocation with Leave to Apply for Readmission. Petitioner is subject to the jurisdiction of the Supreme Court of Florida and the Rules Regulating The Florida Bar.
3. On February 21, 2019, the bar filed a Notice to the Supreme Court of Florida of Petitioner's non-compliance with this court's order dated

February 22, 2018 since petitioner did not submit the required affidavit pursuant to Rule 3-5.1(b) of the Rules Regulating the Florida Bar.

4. On October 1, 2021, petitioner was convicted by a jury in Palm Beach County of an organized scheme to defraud and two counts of money laundering. Petitioner has not yet been sentenced.

5. Petitioner is currently charged in Broward County with grand theft and practicing law while suspended or disbarred.

6. The following disciplinary charges are currently pending against the Petitioner:

A. The Florida Bar File No. 2021-50,710(15E) is pending before a referee on The Florida Bar's Petition for Contempt and Order to Show Cause. The allegations concern petitioner's engaging in the practice of law and obtaining legal fees when no longer a member of the Florida Bar in good standing.

7. Petitioner contends that granting this Petition will not adversely affect the public interest, the integrity of the courts, or the confidence of the public in the legal profession. Further, Petitioner contends that granting this Petition will not hinder the administration of justice.


8. Petitioner states that by signing this petition he is not admitting to any criminal matters as contained in paragraphs (5) and

9. Petitioner understands that the granting of this petition by the Supreme Court of Florida shall serve to dismiss all pending disciplinary cases.

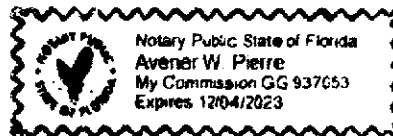


