**MOTION TO CONSOLIDATE AND FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE
REPORT OF REFEREE**

COMES NOW, The Florida Bar on behalf of the Honorable Matthew MacLeod Foxman, and moves this court for an extension of time for the referee to file his report and says:

1. In Florida Supreme Court Case No. SC21-291, this court issued its order directing the Chief Judge to appoint a referee within 14 days with the report of referee to be filed within 180 days of the order appointing the referee, or August 23, 2021.

2. On May 18, 2021 The Florida Bar filed a second Complaint in Florida Bar File No. 2021-00,363(4A). This case was assigned Florida Supreme Court Case No. SC21-724.

3. On May 21, 2021 The Honorable Raul Zambrano, Chief Judge of the Seventh Judicial Circuit, appointed the Honorable Matthew MacLeod Foxman as referee in SC21-724.

4. On May 30, 2021 The Florida Bar filed a Motion to Consolidate SC21-291 and SC21-724 for all subsequent proceedings, including the Trial and Final Hearing on Recommended Discipline.

5. On June 7, 2021 the Referee granted the bar's Motion to Consolidate. All pleadings to date are properly before the Referee.

6. Both cases are consolidated and are set for a two week trial to begin on December 6, 2021 in Volusia County, Florida.

7. The referee will need a sufficient period of time to issue his report.

8. The bar has conferred with David Taylor, respondent, who does not object to this filing of this motion.

9. The bar has conferred with the Honorable Matthew MacLeod Foxman, Referee, who does not object to this filing of this motion.

WHEREFORE, The Florida Bar prays this Honorable Court will consolidate SC21-724 into SC21-291 and issue an order granting the referee an extension of time until February 4, 2022 to file his report in this matter.
