**THE FLORIDA BAR'S REPLY TO RESPONDENT'S RESPONSE TO
PETITION FOR CONTEMPT AND ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE**

COMES NOW The Florida Bar and files its Reply to Respondent's
Response to Petition for Contempt and Order to Show Cause and states:

1. Respondent held himself out as an attorney after February 18, 2021, the effective date of his emergency suspension.
2. On April 5, 2021, respondent engaged in email communications, "as counsel for the opposing party," in Boyles v. Boyles, case number 1994-DR-008498, with Ms. Birnbaum, opposing counsel, and requested a continuance of the hearing date. A copy of the email dated April 5, 2021 is attached hereto as Exhibit "A."
3. Since Ms. Birnbaum was aware of respondent's suspension, she did not believe it was appropriate to communicate with respondent

4. Respondent's order of emergency suspension was not modified in any manner from February 18, 2021 to the present date.

WHEREFORE, The Florida Bar respectfully requests this Honorable Court find respondent, George Edward Ollinger, III, in violation of this Court's Order and impose against him the sanction of disbarment as well as an assessment of administrative costs totaling \$1,250.00.
