**MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO
SUBMIT RESPONSE TO COMMENTS**

The Workgroup on Improved Resolution of Civil Cases (“Workgroup”), by and through its undersigned chair, the Honorable Robert Morris, Chief Judge of the Second District Court of Appeal, respectfully files this motion for an extension of time to submit the Workgroup’s response to the comments received in this case.

By order dated March 16, 2022, the Supreme Court granted all interested persons an extension of time through May 2, 2022, to file comments in response to the Workgroup’s petition and extended the Workgroup’s response deadline to May 23, 2022. The Supreme Court subsequently granted a second extension by order dated April 18, 2022, granting all interested persons an extension of time through June 1, 2022, to file comments in response to the Workgroup’s petition and extending the Workgroup’s response deadline to June 22, 2022. To date, the Workgroup has received 68 comments, some of which have been late filed.

There is insufficient time before June 22, 2022, for the 10-member Workgroup to meet to review, discuss, and determine the appropriate responses to the concerns and issues raised in the comments.

Given that this is a proceeding to amend the Florida Rules of Court, there is no opposing counsel to consult to determine if there is an objection to this motion under Florida Rule of Appellate Procedure 9.300(a).

Wherefore, the Workgroup respectfully requests this Court to grant an extension of time through September 20, 2022, to submit the Workgroup's response to the comments received in this matter.


