
**APPOINTMENT OF THE HONORABLE MICHAEL BAGGÉ-HERNÁNDEZ
AS REFEREE IN BAR DISCIPLINARY ACTION**

The Chief Justice of the Florida Supreme Court has designated the chief judge of this circuit to appoint a referee to preside in a disciplinary action brought by The Florida Bar under Chapter 3 of the Rules Regulating The Florida Bar. By the power vested in the chief judge under Florida Rule of General Practice and Judicial Administration 2.215(b)(2), the Honorable Michael Baggé-Hernández is appointed as referee in the matter of: *The Florida Bar v. Christopher Michael Reynolds*, Supreme Court Case Number SC22-1659.

The Honorable Michael Baggé-Hernández, as referee, is vested with all the powers and prerogatives conferred by the Constitution, laws of the State of Florida, and the Rules Regulating the Florida Bar, concerning a referee for the Supreme Court of Florida in this matter.
