On Monday, June 6, 2022, this Court held Respondent Jonathan Benjamin Lewis in contempt of court for failure to respond in writing to an official inquiry of The Florida Bar. Based on this misconduct, the Court suspended him from the practice of law until he fully responded in writing to the official Bar inquiry and until further order of this Court. On July 8, 2022, this Court received a "Notice of Compliance and Motion to Dissolve Suspension" from Respondent. On July 18, 2022, this Court received a "Response to Respondent's Notice of Compliance and Motion to Dissolve Suspension" from The Florida Bar, notifying this Court that Lewis has now fully responded in writing to the official Bar inquiry. Having complied with this Court's order, Respondent


